He is also a recipient of the State Foresters Award, Rancher of the Year honors from the Utah Section of Range Management Society and the Utah Farm Bureau Conservation Rancher/Farmer of the Year. He was also named an Outstanding Legislator by the Veterans of Foreign Wars.
